

School survey 2009-10

Thank you for the returns, this was the exact format that OFSTED use (not one we would have used in terms of the wording etc). Not every question was answered by everyone.

The children are also undertaking a survey at the moment, results will be published in the New Year.

How do we use the results ?

In reality we are always 'chasing the rainbow' as we believe we can always improve, this survey allows us to look at what we are doing and how we are doing it. We take any suggestions seriously and consider anything that could improve the experiences for all of the children.

Responses:

There were 88 returns representing approximately 48% of the parents (this is in line with the majority of schools % returns)

There were 16 very, very positive comments, 1 suggestion and 2 negative comments (these were specific issues which will be addressed via the class teacher's curriculum update).

Class results:

Reception = 68% of parents (21% of the total)

Year 1 = 57 % of parents (17% of the total)

Year 2 = 59% of parents (16% of the total)

Year 3 = 54% of parents (15% of the total)

Year 4 = 42 % of parents (10% of the total)

Year 5 = 40% of parents (10% of the total)

Year 6 = 44 % of parents (11% of the parents)
