

Year 2 Curriculum Update May 2023

Inter Nation Media Station

Just before half term, we began our next theme called "Inter-Nation Media Station." This is a thematic unit, based on media and broadcasting, with a key focus on history, through which we will be learning about early methods of communication, leading to the invention of both the television and radio.



Maths

In maths, we have been learning about fractions. The children have been developing their understanding of the language 'parts' and 'whole.' They have used their understanding to recognise, find and name a half and a quarter in shapes and quantities. We have also been learning about unit and non-unit fractions and how to recognise, find and name two quarters and three quarters.

English

As part of our theme we have started learning how to write newspaper reports. We have looked at different newspaper articles and identifying their features such as headlines, captions, pictures and past

History

As part of the history in our theme, we started to find out about how people communicated in the past and how it has changed and developed over time. We paid particular attention to the use of Semaphore flags and how these have been used on land and at sea in the military.
