Reading

We have started to send home some books from our reading scheme. These will be a mixture of books with no words and books with small words. The books with no words are to encourage the children to make up and create their own story with the idea being each time they open the book they could tell a new story. We will also send home books with short CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words in where we are encouraging the children to sound out the words using their phonics then blend the word together. When they are sounding out the words, please encourage them to use the letter sound not the name. For example, 'S' makes the 'ssssssss' sound. Please ask if you are unsure!

Things coming home...

We had a new member of our class join us last week, Sonny the Bear. Sonny travels around to different houses and has a special book inside his bag so we can document his adventures. You can add and photos or drawings to show us what you have been doing too!
