Hello everyone! We have now been back in school for 3 weeks and are very happy with how the children have settled back into the daily routines. Well done all of them. This update is just a short celebration of some of the children's work since they have returned and a rough overview of the routines and the theme for the summer term.

Theme

We have continued studying castles and in particular their features. The children have completed virtual tours of many including Windsor castle and locally Goodrich. Alongside this the children have labelled the parts of a castle, designed, and constructed catapults in which they have tested their propulsion. We will continue their learning culminating in them building their own model castles.

We have also continued writing about dragons using Zog by Julia Donaldson, The Egg by M.P. Robertson and the poem Portrait of a Dragon. Children have also enjoyed drawing and designing shields and Coat of Arms.

Maths

Children have continued their learning alongside the platform of Whiterose. Over the past few weeks, they have concentrated on the topics of shape and fractions.
