The children have taken this term on with enthusiasm, and it has been lovely to see so many of them taking on new challenges and experiences with courage and excitement.

'Mission Control'

The term has started off with a blast as we launched into learning about space. As scientists, the children have been exploring the different planets and how the Earth, Moon and Sun move in relation to each other. As writers, the children have written some superb double-page spreads about the different types of Full Moon, which they have found very interesting. As designers, the class have built and attempted to launch a rocket, and we hope to have another attempt at this soon.











We have explored the movement of Earth in relation to the Sun by checking how our shadows change during the day and noticing the position of the Sun in the sky.







How can you help at home?

We are not able to observe the night's sky at school so if there is any opportunity for your children to do some star gazing or observe the skies at night, in the evening or in the morning, please allow them and encourage them to do so. What awe and wonder can they see? There are also apps that you can download that will map the skies for them and show them the stars, constellations and planet positions. The children may also be able to keep a track on the rare seven-planet alignment that will be visible in the early night sky in February.

Homework & 40 reads

This continues to be the same with regular games on TT Rockstars and Spelling Shed. Daily reading, which must be recorded in their school diaries, and an occasional research homework - the children will be responsible for recording this in their diaries.
