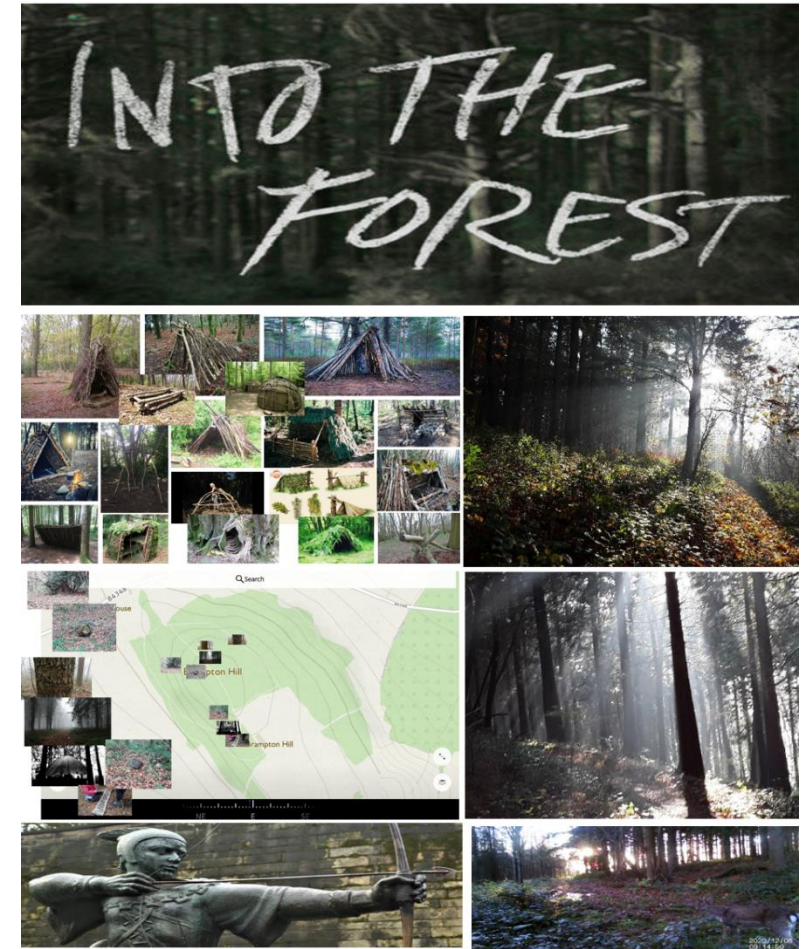


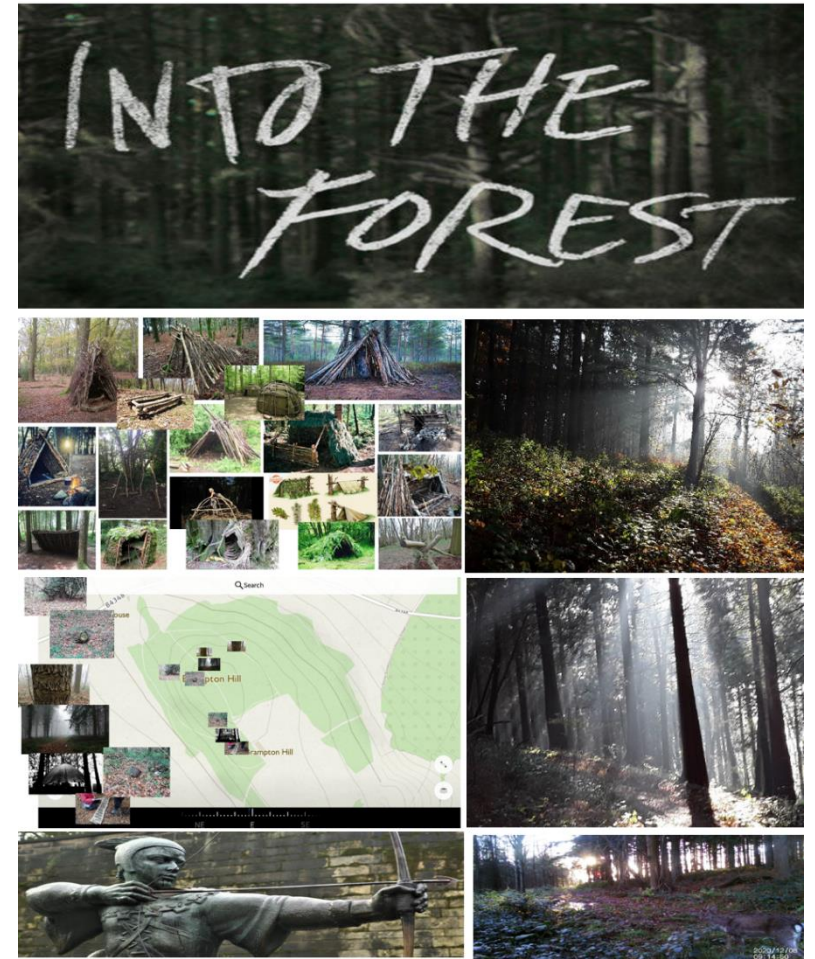
What worked well?

- Science



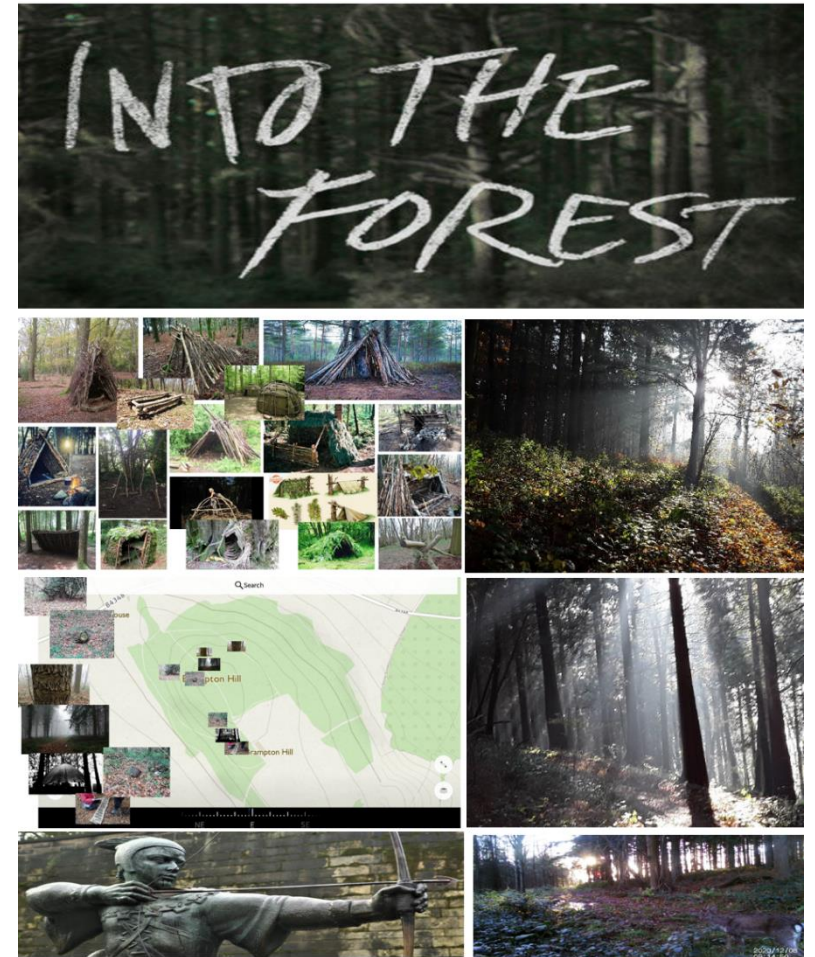
What has been the strongest most memorable aspect of learning?

- French because we have learnt a new language



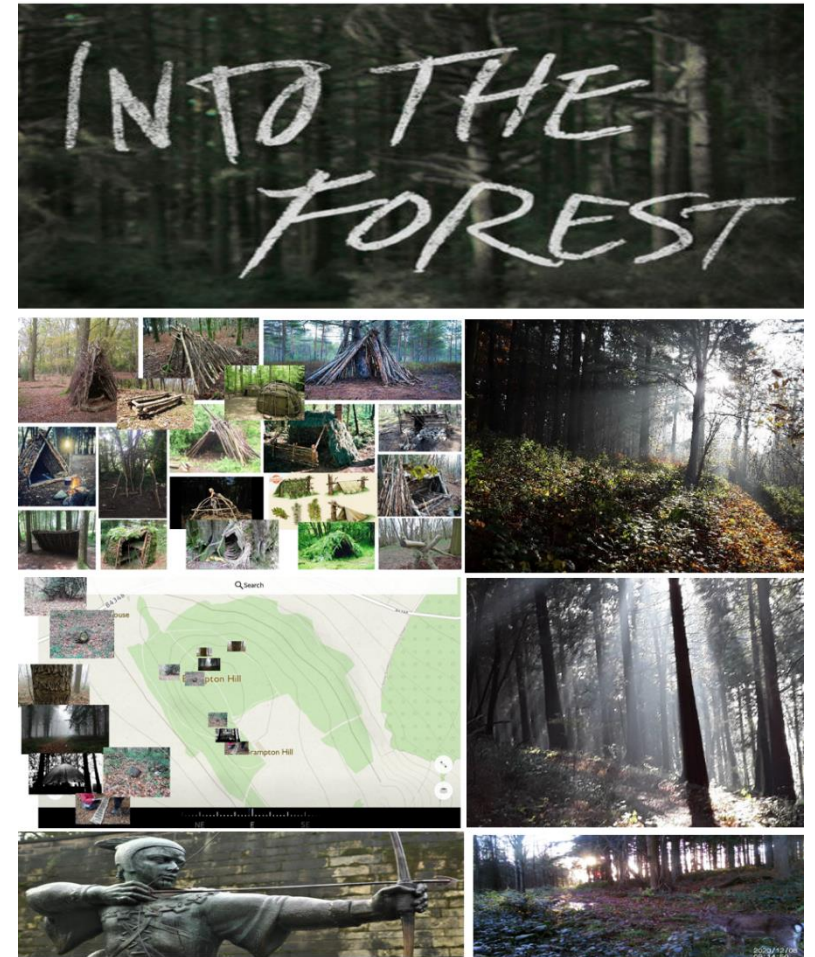
What surprised you about the theme?

- Finding out about the Stone Age and how long ago it was



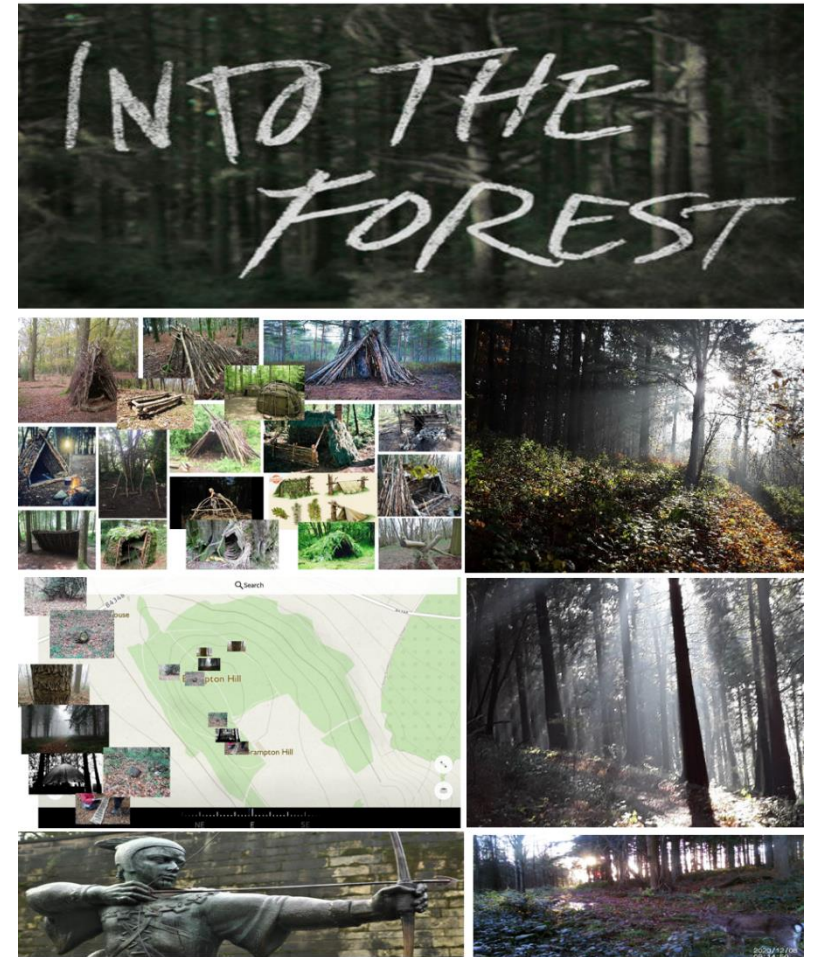
What challenged you?
