Class 2 weekly curriculum update

Values: Peace and Friendship

Hello and we hope you are safe and well. Well done and thank you again for all the work you are completing and sending in for Mrs Baker and I to review and mark.

As mentioned in last week's curriculum update you will find the learning tasks that are needed each day in different places. They will include Seesaw; Spelling Shed, Whiterose maths and in some cases we may use BBC and other teaching websites. We realise with some of these task sheets need to be printed off. We are trying to keep these to a minimum, however if you are unable to do this then do feel free to just send in your answers on a lined sheet of paper. The children's presentation of work will benefit from writing in pencil, rather than biro, as this gives them better control. Regarding Maths there will be some Active maths tasks set through the coming weeks and these can be recorded with photographs or videos. In Science, we will continue researching materials and in History, the children will be writing their own timelines on castles. In P.E. the children will again be set a range of tasks to complete and again see if they can improve on them the following session.

In year 2 we will do:

Monday	Maths/ English(short burst)/ Forest School/PSHE/RE
Tuesday	Maths / English(theme)/ PE /History
Wednesday	Maths/English (theme)/Science
Thursday	Maths/English/P.E./Handwriting.
Friday	Maths/ English (comprehension)/Art/Music.

Daily tasks:

15 minutes every day on TT Rockstars

15 minutes every day on Spelling Shed.

At least 20minutes every day spent reading – this is in addition to the reading tasks that are set.

Maths:

For Maths, we will be using Whiterose, which you will hopefully be familiar with from the March

lockdown. The sequence of learning and questions set are what we use in school.

You will find the teaching videos on their website https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-2/ and I will post the associated worksheets on the working from home section of the class page.

If you find your child is really struggling with the Year 2 maths then please look at the work from previous

year groups to find something more suited. It is better they are confident and happy and reinforcing skills by going over things rather than becoming deflated by getting confused. Class 1 will be using the Whiterose resources too and therefore you will be able to find a level that works for them and you on these class pages. If you decide to use previous Year groups please find the teaching videos on https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/ and select the year group needed. This week's Maths will continue to concentrate on sharing and grouping tasks.

Other work will be set on Seesaw each day for you to access. Mrs. Baker and I will be available to respond on this forum between 10am and 2.30 pm. Work sent after four may not be responded to till the following day. On Monday it will only be Mrs. Baker responding and on Thursday Mr. Hutton only. On the other days, both of us will respond as quickly as we can. Seesaw is a platform where we can provide your child with feedback on their work, however if you have any questions in addition to this please email school and I will get back to you as soon as possible.
