Values: Trust and Friendship

This half term, Year 2 started their new theme called 'Royal Patrons.' Our theme looks at the lives and the achievements of Queen Elizabeth II and Queen Victoria.

### Mathematics.

As mathematicians we have been looking at adding and subtracting two-digit numbers. We have used our counting in 10s knowledge from Year 1 to help us find 10 more or 10 less than a number.

Next week we will be looking at adding and subtracting 2-digit numbers crossing the 10s boundary a 10.

### Science.

As scientists this term, we have been learning about different materials and their properties. We have been on a materials hunt around both the classroom and the outdoor environment searching for man-made and natural materials, recording our findings in a table. We have also started to think about why materials are suited to different jobs. E.g a table is made from wood because it is durable and strong.

#### Forest School.

We have been looking at seasonal changes during our recent visits to Forest School. We have talked about the sequence of the seasons and about how the weather changes at different times of the year. During our forest walks, we have been spotting signs of Autumn and collecting natural resources. We noticed that most of the leaves had changed colours from green to reds and yellows, that the sun sets earlier making it darker much earlier and that the deciduous trees are losing their leaves.

# English.

In English we have applied our knowledge of adjectives to write a description of a pair of knickers that we previously based on the story 'The Queen's Knickers' by the author Nicholas Allen. We have also written a non-fiction piece of writing on the Golden State Coach.

Over the next few weeks we will start our new theme of 'Paddington's Passport and be writing a set of instructions on how to make a marmalade sandwich.

# Reading daily
