Y5 CURRICULUM VISIT TO STATFORD UPON AVON ON TUESDAY 25TH MAY 2021

This term, Year 5 have been learning all about performance in their theme 'All the world's a stage...' and we felt the first curriculum visit of this year should be to Stratford upon Avon. Mr Batstone will accompany us as we visit the birthplace of Shakespeare's mother and take part in a workshop around Midsummer Night's Dream, the play they are studying.

We will be the only school visiting on Tuesday 25th May. The team at Mary Arden's Farm have adapted their setting in line with current Covid-safety measures and the robust safety standards we operate in school will be continued throughout our visit.

We have a full day packed with lots of exiting and engaging activities. We need to make an early start so ask that all children be in school by 0750hrs in readiness for a prompt 0800hrs departure. We aim to return at around 1800hrs. Children should wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch with at least one drink (no fizzy drinks please). Please make sure to notify the music teacher if your child has music lessons that day.

You will now receive a payment request via ParentMail. Under the requirements of the Education Reform Act, 1988 we can only meet the cost of the visit by voluntary contributions. We always keep costs to a minimum and ask for a voluntary contribution of £10 per child to help cover the cost of the entry and transport.

Children currently in receipt of Free School Meals and those who have been entitled to FSM at some point within the last 6 years may be eligible for financial support towards the cost of this curriculum visit. The same applies to children whose parents are members of the Armed Forces. Although there is no obligation to contribute and children will not be treated differently according to whether or not any contribution has been made, the visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient. We have never cancelled a curriculum visit before but unfortunately, we may have to in future, as the school budget is very tight.
