As writers we will:

- · write a biography on a designer
- write a persuasive text on a design
- research and write a discussion text on whether children should wear school uniform
- use film clips and images to inspire creative writing
- write instructions on how to make a piece of jewellery/clothing
- write a creative newspaper report on a new fashion

As readers we will:

- check our understanding of the texts we read by asking questions and discussing its meaning
- predict what might happen
- summarise the main ideas
- identify how language, structure and presentation contribute to meaning
- discuss and evaluate how authors use language, including figurative language, considering the impact on the reader
- retrieve and record information from non-fiction
- participate in the Hay festival to "meet" authors

As global citizens we will:

- discuss and consider the importance of equality and addressing stereotypes
- explore the key facts regarding the physical and emotional changes experienced during puberty (as per the new RSE curriculum)

In ICT we will:

- use coding to plot coordinates
- explore how the internet and search engines work
- identify how photos are enhanced within the media and the impact on self image

As geographers we will:

- consider the environmental and economic impact of the fashion industry
- reflect on the growing importance of sustainability within the fashion industry

As artists and designers we will:

- sketch and make detailed observational drawings of different objects
- explore the use of photography within fashion and develop photography skills
- take inspiration from designers of their choice from across a range of genres (e.g fashion, architecture, interiors, landscapes)

As scientists we will:

- explore the theory of evolution and the life of **Charles Darwin**
- look at inheritance, adaptation and DNA
- consider changes the human skeleton over time
- discuss key scientific changes to the body during puberty (as per the new RSE curriculum)
