Occasionally the children may receive a little task linked to their theme, such as completing work or research something in preparation for a future lesson. It will be the children's responsibility to share this with you.

When the children have Forest School, please could they come to school in appropriate old clothes and bring wellies (these can be left in school at all times).








We have been writing poems to show our understanding and knowledge of history. Here are a few we would like to share with you...
