Recently, we have been learning so much about forces. I was very impressed with what the children could remember from their previous learning and we have built on this with being able to define a force as a push or a pull and having a focus on friction. The children have been deepening their understanding of carrying out investigations and thinking about fair testing and changing variables. We will continue with this theme through weekly science lessons as we move onto magnets.

This week, we have delved into our new theme about animation. The children are showing their high levels of enthusiasm for finding out about early animation devices. So far, we have started to make a phenakistiscope and cannot wait to try them out. This has been the starting point so that we can gain an understanding of how a sequence of drawings with minor changes linked can create the illusion of movement.
