Hello all,

We hope that you are safe and well. A few items of information to keep people updated.

1. <u>Return to school</u> - as you will repeatedly see in the press there is lots of 'speculation' about when, if and how we might return to school. There are NO FACTS at the moment and nothing has been shared, discussed or put to schools. Our position remains the same until we are told otherwise (Stay home, save lives, protect the NHS).

We understand that people may be thinking about or having to return to work and child care becomes a concern at that time. At the start of all of this schools were 'asked' to stay open and not told to, we don't have to be but the staff at Madley feel it is right and proper to 'do their bit' and help parents who are on the frontline. At the moment we have a small amount of children which is just about manageable with social distancing and movement, we would have to look very carefully at any requests to accommodate any other children and it is at the discretion of the school.

Once we actually know what the future plans of the administration are we will communicate with you and plan the best course of action. To do anything we must be able to make sure that all the children and staff are safe.

We all want to return to some form of 'normality' as soon as possible.
