Terms and Conditions

Admittance

MASC provides childcare places from 1530hrs to 1730hrs each school day.

Collection of children

We expect children to be collected promptly by either parents or the nominated adults (Please make sure you provide a password on the form) to whom you have given your consent (overleaf). We do, however understand that on rare occasions it may be necessary to make different collection arrangements and ask that you notify us of any changes as quickly as possible. Failure to collect your child on time may result in an additional charge being raised.

Fees

Places must be pre-booked and paid by the 27th of the previous month. A notification of charges will be sent via ParentMail. Payments can be made via ParentMail, in cash or cheque at the school office. Cheques should be made payable to Herefordshire Council. Late payment of fees could jeopardise your child's place at MASC. Full fees will be charged if your child is absent on the days booked, (unless it is a school event i.e. open evening and your child is a tour guide or participating in a class activity or a trip or residential which will be deducted from the following months payment).

Notice

4 weeks' notice is required to cancel **any** hours. Please put this in writing addressed to School Administrator.

Staff

All our staff are qualified and experienced in childcare and have an enhanced DBS disclosure. They are all trained in first aid and have food hygiene certificates.
