

PTA Meeting Notes 27th January 2020

Treasurer Update

The bank account stands at £8529.62, but there is still a cheque for the waterproofs to go out for £757.50.

The cash in hand balance stands at £1228.39

Please could we inform CD of the floats needed for the disco/upcoming events so she can arrange to drop them off and collect them.

JP gave an update on how the PTA can make some changes to be more GDPR compliant. We are now going to call the 'minutes' of our meetings 'Meeting Notes' and these will be sent to SJ to upload onto the PTA section of the website. She will send out a Parentmail notifying everyone they are available for all to view.

As a reminder, no correspondence regarding the PTA should be sent from mobile devices.

Requests for funding

A parent on behalf of Year has asked for a contribution towards this year's leavers celebration. They are purchasing hoodies and providing a party at the village hall. They have calculated a total of £792 including Hoodies, hire of the hall, food and cakes that will work out at £24 per family.

After discussion we agreed on a donation of £100 towards this which we will maintain as a regular contribution to Year 6.

Year 5 and 6 are visiting Think Tank in Birmingham on 19th March and have asked for a contribution towards the cost of the coach hire. After discussion we agreed that the Yr 5 and 6 children could be responsible for supplying and running the cake sale at our next disco on 13th March and we would

donate the total raised from this Disco. They will need to supply made or bought cakes and ensure there are enough and devise a rota for covering the stall on the night with support from EG and a teacher.

Volunteers will also be needed for washing up and monitoring rubbish and recycling.
