## **Treasurer Update**

The bank account stands at £7799.12

The cash in hand balance stands at £1078.39

Please could we inform CD of the floats needed for the disco/upcoming events so she can arrange to drop them off and collect them.

We firstly discussed the upcoming Disco on Friday 13<sup>th</sup> and agreed that we needed to confirm arrangements with Mr Batstone/Yr 5 and 6 teachers with regards to the running of the cake stall. We need to put a communication out asap, asking parents of these children to supply the cakes, bought or made and nut free. We also need to ensure there will be enough child volunteers on the night, both to sell cakes and to wash up/monitor litter.

A Spring Pride event was mentioned and we will ask Mr Batstone if this is something he would like to arrange a date for. JP mentioned the village litter pick which is taking place on the 5<sup>th</sup> April. The group (Madley Litter Pickers) and volunteers will meet at the school at 10.30. We discussed that this was something we could perhaps get involved with next time – supply refreshments etc.

The welfare unit for the Forest School site will be ordered next month. We need to communicate to parents that this has been funded by the PTA.

As our focus of late has been on the older year groups, we would like to ask Years R-3 for any requests for funding so we can ensure all children are benefitting from the PTA fundraising.

We need to send out a NUD reminder for the 20<sup>th</sup> March which will be in return for items for the Easter Bingo (Easter eggs, Easter gifts or craft).

RS has set us up with Amazon Smile which is a service a bit like the giving machine through which you can order form Amazon and the school earns a percentage. This is something we need to let parents know about so we can start benefitting as soon as possible.

ND mentioned a foreign currency scheme that we could possibly try in September, where people can bring in there unwanted foreign currency after their holidays and JP has looked into a similar scheme with stamps. Both may raise minimal funds but may be worth a try.
