Interview example - question and answer

Q. How did you feel when you knew you were going on a dangerous mission that could mean you might not make it back to Britain?

A. We all felt scared but it was part of our job and we were focussed on what we had to do to help win the war. It is what we were trained to do. We knew that some of us would not make it back if we met the German planes in the sky or were shot down and sadly we did lose close friends but fortunately I was very lucky to survive.

Tips – your question should allow Frank to give you detail in his answer. They need to be open questions so they shouldn't be answered with just a yes or no.

Your parents/carers could always imagine they are Frank and give you interview them with your questions to help your answers.
