

Upcycled Denim Bowl



This is a fun way to recycle your old denim clothes by turning them into a funky bowl. This bowl will look great on the side in the kitchen, living room, bedroom or bathroom! It is really versatile and can be used to store all sorts of bits and bobs.

You will need:

Old denim clothing

Tape measure or ruler

A breakfast bowl or similar for the mould

Cling film

White glue

Pair of scissors



Instructions:

1. Begin by cutting your old denim clothes into rectangular strips around three centimetres in width and eight to ten centimetres in length. Do some strips longer so that they reach from one side of the bowl to the other.
2. Turn a bowl upside down and cover it in cling film.
3. Now, glue and layer the strips of denim over the bowl (much like papier-mache) until it is three layers thick.
4. Leave the bowl to dry (this may take overnight).
5. Remove the denim bowl from the mould and remove the cling film. Check it is totally dry.
6. Cut off any excess material from the rim of the bowl.
7. Now use your bowl to store a range of items, such as bobbles, hair clips, keys and toys.
