Welcome to week 2 of your home learning. It has been great to see all of your work you have uploaded using Seesaw. The following details may help you to organise yourselves this week, with a brief look at what we will be covering and any resources you may need in advance for lessons to give you time to get these ready. Remember, that an update will be available on the class page under the home learning section every week. This will be posted by each Monday. Having a routine can be difficult but is very important during times like these but it needs to be a routine that works for you. However, I do suggest where possible that you try and do the Maths and English tasks in the morning if you can. Seesaw is the main source of your learning tasks, although you should be accessing Spelling Shed and TT Rockstars daily. Also, you should be reading at least 15 minutes a day.

English:

Monday – Short Burst

Tuesday – Part 1 of character description from 'The Iron Man'.

Wednesday – Spelling/Grammar

Thursday – Part 2 of character description from 'The Iron Man'

Friday – Reading comprehension.

Remember to practise daily on Spelling Shed.

Maths:

For Maths, we will be using White Rose. As we were due back on a Wednesday in Week 1 after Christmas we still need to finish week 2 before moving onto week 3. You will find the teaching videos on their website <https://whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-3/> and I will post the associated worksheets on both Seesaw and working from home section of the class page. The answers will only be on Seesaw. Please choose whichever way is best for you. If you find your child is really struggling with the Year 3 maths then please look at the work from previous year groups to find something more suited. The focus for this week's lessons are division and scaling.

Monday – Divide 2 digits by 1 digit (2)

Tuesday – Divide 100 into 2, 4, 5 and 10 equal parts (Activity)

Wednesday – Divide with remainders (Activity)

Thursday – Divide 2 digits by 1 digit (3)

Friday – Scaling

Science:

This week, we will continue to look at our work on Light. It was great to see your mind maps and the questions that you sent in. We are going to look at a question many of you sent in, 'How can we see objects?' so will we have activities linked to that and an odd one out challenge.

Art and Design:

For Art, on Friday you will need some resources to make a zoetrope, an optical toy that I shared with you for my instructions last week. You will need either: thick paper or card, scissors, stapler, sellotape, pin and a pencil with a rubber on the top, along with a printer.
